Remember PSO in your Will

There are different ways to support PSO in your Will:

- **A percentage:** a nominated percentage of your total estate.
- **A residual gift:** after providing for your family, you can nominate that you want to leave part, or all of what's left of your estate to PSO.
- **A specific gift:** a specific amount of money, real estate or any gift you wish to nominate.

A gift to Presbyterian Support Otago, no matter the amount, helps us to continue working towards our vision of every person being valued and growing in a safe and strong community.

The wording is important

When you make a Will or add to an existing Will (a codicil) you need to be clear about your wishes. To support our work, we suggest the following wording:

I give to Presbyterian Support Otago (CC20878)

- 1) [a percentage of my estate], or:
- 2) [the residue of my estate], or:
- 3) [the sum of \$....],

for general purposes. I declare that the receipt of the Chief Executive, or other proper officer, will be sufficient receipt and discharge for my trustees".
