

Payroll giving

Payroll giving lets you donate to charity through your wages.



Payroll giving is a voluntary scheme that enables you to make a donation directly from your pay to a charity. For every donation over \$5 you automatically and immediately receive a one-third tax credit back. You will not need to file a claim with the IRD at the end of the tax year for payroll giving.

Payroll Giving provides ongoing, meaningful support for community initiatives such as the Familyworks Foodbank, children's programmes, parenting support, and other unfunded services offered by Presbyterian Support Otago.
